2. How would you describe Jesus' interaction with His mother in this story?

3. In **John 2:4**, Jesus says, "*My hour has not yet come.*" What do you think He meant by this?

- Why do you think Jesus initially seemed reluctant to help with the wine situation?

See **Isaiah 25:6-8**

4. Mary tells the servants, "*Do whatever He tells you*" (**John 2:5**).

- In what areas of your life do you find it challenging to fully obey Jesus?

5. How does the master of the banquet's reaction (**John 2:9-10**) add to the impact of this miracle?

6. What significance do you see in the fact that Jesus' first recorded miracle in John's Gospel took place at a wedding celebration? (see **Genesis 2**)

7. Jesus turned water into wine, transforming something ordinary into something extraordinary.

- What is the **significance** of this miracle (regarding the 6 stone water jugs)
- Where in your life do you need Jesus to bring **transformation**?
- Are you **missing 'ingredients'** for this transformation... do you see this differently after this message?

8. This miracle **revealed Jesus' glory**, and His disciples put their faith in Him (**John 2:11**).

- How has Jesus revealed His glory in your life, and how has it affected your faith?
- Think about what glory means: luminosity, weightiness, essence.

9. How does this story connect with the rest of the Bible and why does it matter?

10. This week, pay attention to the "ordinary" aspects of your life. How might God be working through these everyday moments?

11. Jesus cared about the joy and celebration of others. How can you bring joy to someone else's life this week in a practical way?
